On the 5th May 2011, the Commission held a meeting where the Commissioners have taken cognizance of:

- The Executive Director's Report on the case concerning a possible collusion in the market for secondary books;
- (2) The fact that it has been concluded that the discount rates that are offered to the bookshops by Editions de l'Océan Indien (EOI) and Editions Le Printemps (ELP) differ;
- (3) The fact that no evidence of communication or agreement by EOI and ELP to fix the discount rates has been found;
- (4) The fact that the Commission does not intend to issue any direction as provided for in Section 58 of the Act or to make an order for a penalty as provided for in Section 59 of the Act.¹

In the light of the above, the Commissioners present have unanimously decided that:

- (i) No financial penalty shall be imposed because no intentional or negligent breach of the Act was committed;
- (ii) No direction shall be issued as the parties have not breached the Competition Act 2007;
