Research Assistant (Legal)

The Competition Commission is a statutory body established in 2009 to enforce the Competition Act 2007. It has two independent arms: an investigative arm led by the Executive Director and an adjudicative arm led by the Commission, which comprises of five Commissioners. The law provides the Competition Commission with independent powers to investigate anticompetitive behaviours by businesses and to take necessary corrective measures. Anticompetitive behaviours, also called restrictive business practices, can be in the form of cartels, abuse of monopoly positions and mergers that lead to substantial lessening of competition.

The Competition Commission is currently looking for suitable candidates for the post of **Research Assistant** (Legal). The detailed job description is available on its website www.competitioncommission.mu and at its office at the address below.

As Research Assistant (Legal), the incumbent is required to assist in the investigation of cases and producing timely reports with quality and robust legal analysis for the Executive Director, that are then submitted to the Commission for decision. Research Assistant (Legal) should also assist in conducting market studies and research work in relation to competition matters, as well as conducting advocacy activities and drafting materials for publications. They should keep abreast of international developments in competition legislation and collaborate with competition authorities overseas whenever required.

Minimum requirements: a bachelor's degree in Law from a recognised body or any other equivalent qualifications acceptable to the Competition Commission.
