

In accordance with Rule 9 of the Competition Commission Rules of Procedure 2009, the Executive Director of the Competition Commission is required to produce an administrative timetable which makes provision for the major stages of investigation.

The following timetable has been set for the investigation into proposed acquisition by Vitol Emerald Bidco Propriety Limited of Engen Limited from Petronas Marketing international Sendirian Berhad (the "Proposed Acquisition").

The investigation reference is INV067.

Upon receipt of the Report of Investigation, the Commission shall if so required, conduct a hearing to listen to the views of any person it considers having a relevant interest in the case. As per Rule 29(2) of the Competition Commission Rules of Procedure, "every direction of the Commission shall, as far as practicable be made or issued within 40 days from the date of conclusion of the final arguments".

NOTE: the administrative timetable has been put on hold in view of discussions on undertakings in light of Section 63 of the Competition Act. The investigation itself is ongoing.

¹ In accordance with Rule 9(6) of the Competition Commission Rules of Procedure 2009, where at any point during an investigation, the Executive Director has reason to believe that the administrative timetable will not be met for any reason, he shall prepare a revised timetable and notify all the parties involved.
