

COMMUNIQUE OF THE COMPETITION COMMISSION

Invitation for Expression of Interest for Independent Medical Expert

1. The Competition Commission invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from suitably qualified professionals to act as an Independent Medical Expert (Consultant) for its Private Healthcare Market Inquiry.
2. The Private Healthcare Market Inquiry is being conducted by the Competition Commission pursuant to section 51B of the Competition Act 2007 (the Competition Act). The inquiry is assessing potential harm to competition that may arise from market features relating to the supply of private healthcare services in Mauritius. Among other matters, the inquiry is examining concentration levels, referral practices, preferred-provider networks, and transparency in prices and service levels.
3. In this regard, the Consultant is expected to provide technical assistance to the Inquiry team to support its understanding of complex medical terminology, clinical practices, patient referral mechanisms, and standard medical protocols. The Consultant is also expected to provide input in evaluating the cost of medical procedures and benchmarking the coding of local private healthcare institutions' billing systems against international best practices. The Consultant's technical insights will be critical in assessing clinical realities within the competition law framework.
4. The Consultant is expected to work on a part-time basis during the period October 2026 to October 2027 on as when required basis. The terms and conditions would be mutually agreed upon in due course.
5. This call for EOI is open to all interested local parties who meet the following set criteria.
 - Practising or retired professionals in the medical or health economics field,
 - At least 10 years' professional experience in the healthcare sector.
 - Sound knowledge of the organisation and operation of healthcare services in Mauritius.
 - Proven experience in providing independent medical expert/consultancy services.
6. The EOI should include a curriculum vitae and a brief statement of relevant experience.

7. The EOI, clearly marked **Ref: CC/MI001/1 “Expression of Interest”**, should be sent by email on info@competitioncommission.mu at latest by **14:00 hours local time on 08 October 2026**.
8. Applicants shortlisted through the EOI process may subsequently be invited to submit a technical and financial proposals with a view to entering into an Agreement with the Competition Commission.
9. Any request for additional information should be sent to the above-mentioned email.
10. The Competition Commission reserves the right to accept or reject either in whole or in part, any interest expressed and to annul the whole EOI without thereby incurring any liability whatsoever to any applicant.
